RM RESPONSES TO DIA23 REPORT PART B ITEMS:

Meeting for Learning working group Report as of 11.5.23

CRQ:

- **1.** We support the recommendation that Meeting for Learning program format continue as it currently stands.
- 2. We support the formation of a new support group in order to facilitate the ongoing support of Meeting for Learning into 2024.
- 3. We also hear a suggestion that the Working Group or new Committee might consider utilising the resources of Silver Wattle.

NSWRM:

We support the Part B recommendations:

- 1. We recommend that Meeting for Learning continue in its current form.
- 2. We suggest that a new AYM Committee, perhaps called the Meeting for Learning Support Committee, be established as:
 - a) An "interest" committee of four Friends, from anywhere in Australia
 - b) Main tasks, the administration and oversight of Meeting for Learning, including handling finances, publicity, timelines, liaison with the facilitators and the host Regional Meeting
 - c) Report to AYM.
 - d) To meet as often as the work requires
 - e) Initial nominations perhaps after calling for expressions of interest. There is a wide "alumnus" of previous participants who may be interested.
- 3. The Host RM and the facilitators would continue as outlined above.
- 4. We would suggest that the Meeting for Learning Support Committee consider having its own email address. It's also possible that the Committee may feel led to manage a Meeting for Learning webpage.
- 5. We suggest that the current Facilitators and David Barry as the SANTRM host RM and Sharon Mathews from WARM continue as a Working Group to support MFL for 2023 in the interim.

ORM:

We note the suggestion from DiA regarding the formation of a Meeting for Learning Support Committee. We hope this will be done.

SANTRM:

- 1. We are happy that Meeting for Learning proposes to continue in its current form. We hope that the current facilitators and David Barry from the SANTRM host meeting and Sharon Matthews from WARM continue as a Working Group to support Meeting for Learning for 2023.
