Summary (400 words or less) <i>include number attending your event</i>	<p>44 Friends attended</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All of the venues proposed are the same as, or in the vicinity of, the venues during YM17. • The conveners shared information about the booking made so far by SANTRM - the Barcoo Room at the Sea Rescue, a venue for large group gatherings. • They shared photos of the proposed accommodation venues: Shacks at The Retreat of the West Beach Park, and the Caravan Park at West Beach Parks. A booking will be made for a number of shacks. Friends will need to book for Caravan Pk accommodation • They shared information and photos of proposed venues for evening meals at the Sailing Club and lunch at the Pool Room of The Retreat at West Beach Parks. (The dining area will be more accessible than it was in YM17.) • They shared photos of proposed sites for the Children and JYFs. Children will have a venue at The Retreat. JYFs may be at a venue close by. Arrangements can be made for a gathering of Young Friends before YM, if there is a need. • Friends shared ideas and suggestions about holding a hybrid YM24. It was suggested that there be separate Friendly Schools and Share and Tell sessions for those online and those in person. • Holding a hybrid YM in 2024 is an experiment for the host SANTRM, who reminded those present that not all features of an online or face to face Yearly Meeting can be accommodated • SANTRM Friends will need support from other Regional Meetings for a range of activities. • The YMOC, which continues its work after YM23, has co-opted Topsy Evans to the committee. • Information about YM24 is already on the YM website. Updated information will be posted as it becomes available. • Friends are encouraged to contact the convenor of YMOC for information about YM24 arrangements and to offer assistance.
