Beginning of the Metta Bhavana, a Buddhist meditation based on the cultivation of loving-kindness towards all living beings, in five stages:

- 4 1st Bell: Developing loving-kindness towards yourself.
- 2nd Bell: Developing loving-kindness towards a good friend.
- **3rd Bell**: Developing loving-kindness towards a neutral person.
- 4th Bell: Developing loving-kindness towards a difficult person.
- 5th Bell: Extending loving-kindness outwards to encompass the earth and all beings everywhere.


End of the meditation, marked by 3 consecutive bells.

Warren Entsch's office

Bells are being rung at **St Margaret's Anglican Church in Cairns** directly across the road from **MP Warren Entsch**, Special Envoy for the Great Barrier Reef. This will be followed by singing and **a multi faith protest** outside his office where he will be invited to sign the Statement calling for **net zero emissions by 2030**.
