EVACUATION PROCEDURES

- Follow all instructions given by Wardens or Emergency Officers
- Leave immediately by the nearest safe exit and do not use lifts in a fire situation
- Move quickly, do not run
- If possible, close doors behind you
- Report to your designated assembly area
- Do not leave the assembly area until the designated Emergency Officer gives the "all-clear"
- If any injuries are sustained, notify and Emergency Officer
- Advise an Emergency Officer immediately if you are aware of people trapped in the building

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS



Remove persons from immediate danger



Alert nearby staff and members of the public and call 000 (operate manual call point if possible)



Confine fire and smoke, close windows and doors (if safe) and keep low under the smoke



Extinguish and control the fire (if safe to do so)
