

EVACUATION SIGN

EVACUATION PROCEDURES

- Follow all instructions given by Wardens or Emergency Officers
- Leave immediately by the nearest safe exit and do not use lifts in a fire situation
- Move quickly, do not run
- If possible, close doors behind you
- Report to your designated assembly area
- Do not leave the assembly area until the designated Emergency Officer gives the "all-clear"
- If any injuries are sustained, notify and Emergency Officer
- Advise an Emergency Officer immediately if you are aware of people trapped in the building

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

- R** Remove persons from immediate danger
- A** Alert nearby staff and members of the public and call 000 (operate manual call point if possible)
- C** Confine fire and smoke, close windows and doors (if safe) and keep low under the smoke
- E** Extinguish and control the fire (if safe to do so)

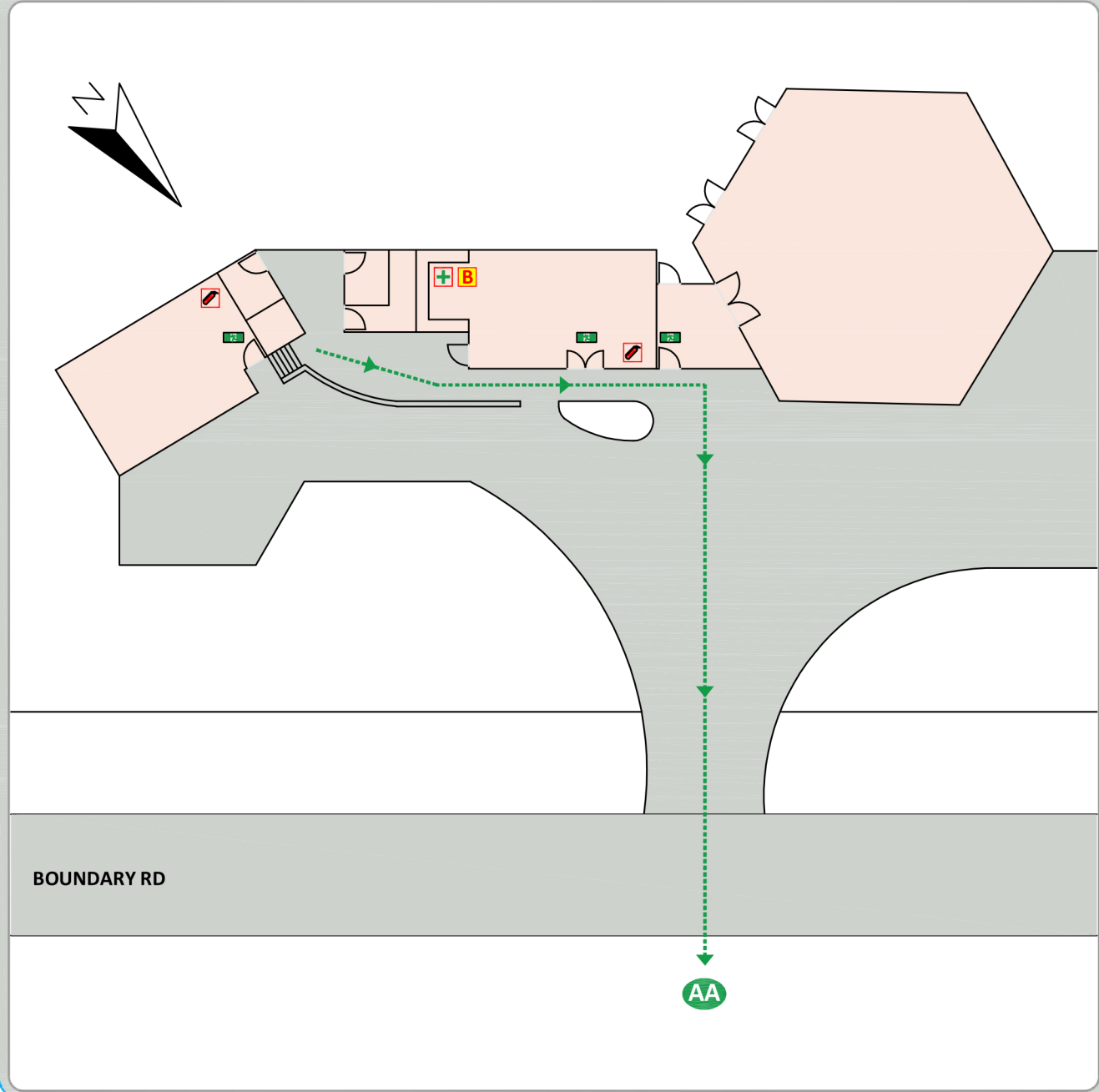
Operating Instructions & Applications

- A**im the nozzle
- S**queeze the trigger
- S**weep the base of the fire
